Birmingham City Council Proposes Cutting Support Services to Vulnerable People

The Government has already cut £590 million per year to Birmingham.

That is £530 per person per year. More cuts are to come. The budget to be set on February 28th asks councillors to vote for cuts to services for our most vulnerable people, including homeless families, those with disabilities such as mental health and learning disabilities, young people at risk, and women and children suffering domestic violence.



If these cuts are approved, the 'Not for Profit' organisations will have no choice but to cut support services with up to a half of them closing completely.

This will be devastating for the 1000's of Birmingham citizens who need support to live safely and independently.

Please support the call for Birmingham Councillors to say 'No!' to these and any further cuts to the poorest and most vulnerable. Speak out for those who have no voice.

Cuts to provision will NOT save money

and will only serve to INCREASE the cost through increased demand for the council's and other statutory services.

There will be more people sleeping on the streets, families with children in Bed and Breakfast, increased homelessness, more children looked after, additional pressure on a struggling NHS and other key services, and an increased risk of violence, serious harm and even death.
